

Frequently asked questions

What is the adult-to-child ratio?

Maximum adult-to-child ratio is 1 to 8. Because of our commitment to your child(ren)'s fun and safety, we will maintain a waiting list throughout the summer rather than over-filling our camps.

What does your school offer to ensure my child's safety?

Grace Lutheran Preschool & Kindergarten, where our summer camps take place, is fully secure. We have a lock-down security system that isolates our school from church foot traffic as well as a policy of locking classroom doors when children are in attendance. After camp starts each day, the school is locked. Visitors are only admitted upon recognition by office staff and they must sign in and wear a badge during their stay.

How do we register?

Sign up now! Complete a **2018 Young Explorer Camp registration form** and return it with the \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee as soon as possible. Registration is limited and placements are made on a first-come, first-served basis. Confirmations will be mailed in April and final class placement will be made shortly before camp begins.

What is your cancellation policy?

You will receive a confirmation letter as soon as your registration has been processed. Changes to confirmed registrations **MUST** be made in writing at least one week prior to the first day of camp. Canceling within one week of camp may result in lost tuition. June 18-22, 2018 9:00-noon






Young Explorer Camp #2

June 25-29, 2018 9:00-noon


