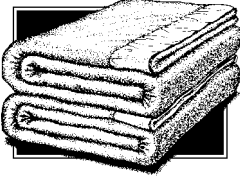

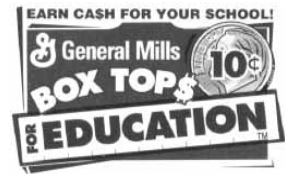
## Lutheran World Relief Blanket Sunday



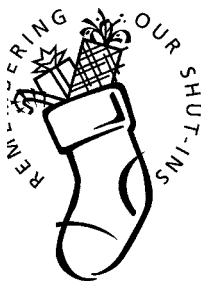
The first Sunday of October Women of Grace have traditionally sponsored the collection of new and gently used blankets, quilts, health kits, sewing kits, school kits, soap, and baby layettes for distribution to people in need. These items are collected all through the months of September and October, and delivered to a shipping agency for delivery to Lutheran World Relief. The sponsor for this project is the Esther Circle.

## Box Tops for Education

These labels are found on General Mills products and are collected for the purchase of items needed for the Dayschool. Families of Grace are encouraged to bring these coupons to the church. ## Stockings for Centre Crest



Every year Women of Grace are asked to make and fill Christmas Stockings for the residents of Centre Crest. The Sewing Circle makes the stockings and women of the various circles fill the stockings with items needed for the residents' daily care. This past year 30 stockings were assembled. We are one of the largest contributors to this ministry.

## Baby Shower for Morning Star

During the month of May, Women of Grace collect baby items for the Morning Star Pregnancy Center, Harrisburg, PA. These are non-profit, interdenominational agencies offer compassion and practical assistance to women who face an untimely pregnancy. The counselors show Christ's love to each woman by offering her unconditional acceptance, emotional support, friendship, information, referrals and material aid. They minister to each woman's needs regardless of her race or creed, before and after birth, without cost, recognizing that she, too, is a child of God. The sponsor for this project is the Dorcas/Lydia Circle.



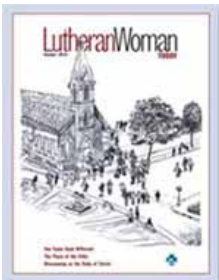
## Lutheran World Relief Coffee Project

# SHUT-IN VISITATION

The times for shut-in visitation are arranged between the Women of Grace and those whom they are visiting.

Program Theme: As ambassadors for Christ, the Women of Grace spend time visiting members and friends of Grace who cannot leave their homes. We visit to be a friend and listener.

## Suggestions for Visitors

1. Be a listener and remember you are their friend.
2. Be faithful and do not disappoint them. If you promise to run an errand, be sure to do it.
3. Be patient and cheerful.
4. Call in advance to plan the date and time of your visit. Plan your visit to have adequate time to spend with the shut-in. Arrive on time.
5. Be objective and do not let pity be obvious.
6. Witness your faith.
7. Be reassuring and leave them with good thoughts to remember.
8. Keep a notebook to record your visit for your own information when you visit them again.
9. Remember birthdays and other special days, but take gifts only on rare occasions.
10. Do not discuss the shut-in's condition with others present unless you are sure you are not within hearing distance of the shut-in.
11. Share confidentially with the pastors any information which may be helpful in ministering to the particular shut-in.
