

ABOUT TODAY'S THEME...God is the source of our nourishment. Our Lord's invitation to "take and eat . . . take and drink" is a repeated one. In the holy eucharist, in the word read and proclaimed, in the assembly of the people of God, the dominion of God has come near. Rejoice! Your name is written in heaven.

ABOUT THE LESSONS.... **The First Lesson:** Those who returned from the exile found that the hopes for the glorious restoration of Judah were not completely fulfilled. For these disappointed people, the prophet envisions salvation in the image of a nursing woman. Mother Jerusalem and a mothering God remind the community how they are sustained and supported. **The Second Lesson:** In the close of his letter to the Galatians, Paul encourages them to live as people made right with God through faith in Jesus Christ. Here Paul offers practical advice about how believers exercise common concern for one other in "the family of faith." **The Gospel Lesson:** Jesus commissions harvesters and laborers to go where he would go and do what he would do. Risking hardship and danger in exchange for the experience of great joy, they offer peace and healing as signs that the reign of God is near.

Sponsors needed for youth mission trip to New York City - Faith



Music Teacher Needed



Hiring for the 2019-20 School Year - Music Teacher/Specialist

GLPK is looking for a highly motivated and energetic music teacher for the 2019-20 school year! The music teacher is responsible for planning and implementing developmentally appropriate music classes based on the school's music curriculum, for children aged 2 1/2 through kindergarten. The music teacher must be available three mornings per week to teach up to eleven 20 to 30 minute classes per week. (Number of weekly classes is dependent on school enrollment.) The music teacher is also responsible for planning and implementing two performances at a small day-time church service; an evening Christmas Program; and a performance at a local retirement center.
